

ROUGH TERRAIN FORKLIFT

Course Number: AS 1110

Duration of course: 1 day (8 hours each)

Ratio: Classroom - 20 students to 1 instructor
Practical - 8 students to 1 instructor

This course is recommended for personnel working in any industry where forklifts are utilized.

SYNOPSIS OF COURSE:

This course focuses on forklift OSHA and operational requirements, including safety and hands-on practical applications. Students will be required to successfully demonstrate the ability to operate a rough terrain forklift.

REQUIREMENTS:

High School diploma or equivalent. Ability to read and speak the English language. Students must be medically and physically fit to perform hands-on activities.

- Responsibilities of forklift operators
- OSHA & ANSI standards
- Accident Prevention
- General forklift rules and regulations
- Mechanics of a forklift
- General forklift inspection
- Hands-on forklift driving practical evaluation
